If you purchased an Irish Ink Aftercare Kit, it will include Aquaphor (healing ointment), liquid antibacterial soap (fragrance and dye free), and Aveeno Baby Cream (fragrance and dye free). You can also purchase all these items at your local drug or grocery store.

Days	Treatment	Initials
First 48 Hours	Make sure to wash your hands with the antibacterial soap before touching the fresh tattoo. This is a precaution to keep bacteria out of your healing skin. Wash the area with antibacterial soap then rinse as needed. Apply the Aquaphor or similar ointment liberally.	
Day 1 - Day 4	Wash your tattoo with antibacterial soap (fragrant and dye free) three times daily. Be sure to build up a good lather in your hands then apply it to your tattoo. Rinse off all the soap with water then blot dry. Once dry, apply a thin layer of Aquaphor healing ointment to the tattoo.	
Day 4 – Day 20	Continue to wash the location with antibacterial soap. From day 5 you can start applying the baby cream, in place of Aquaphor, to your tattoo. You should apply the baby cream to the tattoo 3 times a day for about 2 to 3 weeks.	

As healing progresses you will notice a slight to moderate s	cab forming over the tattoo. This is normal and will eventual
